Let's see how many of these lovely blooms we can find.

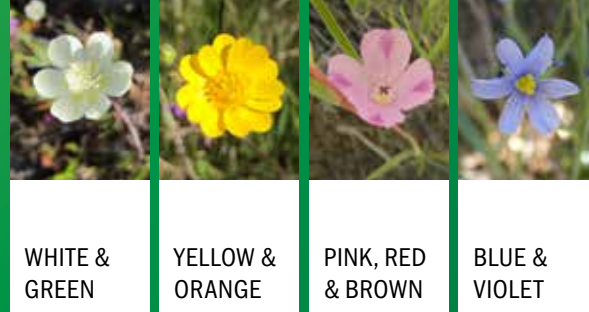

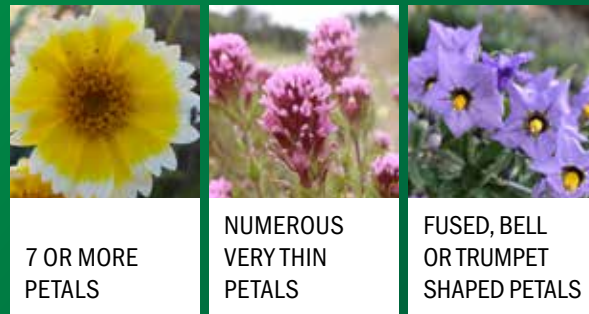
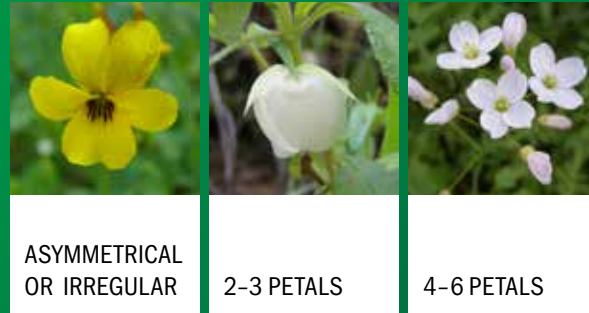
